

Emergency food and utility assistance, housing rehabilitation projects, thrift stores, and newborn layettes are a few examples of what these ministries do.

The House of the Carpenter is a Christ-centered charity affiliated with the West Virginia Conference of the United Methodist Church. Located in Wheeling, WV, it serves those in need in the Upper Ohio Valley. We value openness and integrity in our interactions with our neighbors, volunteers, staff, and community. And we are committed to caring for the whole person: Body, Mind, and Soul.

Our overarching goal is both simple and complex: **We make sure** that all of God's children are welcomed into a community that is safe and filled with grace. Our neighbors have faced an uphill battle to survive and thrive for decades. The Wheeling economy has struggled since the coal and steel industries began to decline in the 1970s. In response, we have developed various ministries that support and empower our community.

We provide for basic needs by operating a food pantry and an underwear and diaper room and providing utility assistance. Additionally, we provide programs for all ages to deepen their education, broaden their experience, and enrich their lives. Examples include Madison Elementary Partnership, After-School Brain Train, STEM Camp, Literacy Camp, Summer Meals, Art Lessons, Senior Walking and Board Games, Adult Cooking, Self-Defense, SMART Recovery Family Support, and Bible Study.
