


ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL

We invite you to join us for Sunday School at 10:00am prior to Worship Service. You will increase your knowledge about the Bible, enjoy great fellowship, and prepare your heart and mind for worship service. We are starting a new quarter of learning on Sunday, March 3 focused on the theme, "Encounters in Prayer and Love."

The first five lessons will continue the Lenten focus. They take us inside the story of Jesus as he moves toward the cross, particularly looking at Jesus' prayers during this time, including his prayer for his disciples, his prayer for the church, and his anguished prayer in the garden. They encourage us to sit in Jesus' presence as he prays these poignant prayers and then call us to celebrate because of the hope Jesus' resurrection brings.

With the hope of resurrection fresh in our hearts, eight lessons will flow naturally into a vision of peace, reconciliation, and healing in our fractured and polarized world. The overall emphasis is on the relational dimensions of mission, especially as Jesus and the early church encounter the stranger, the marginalized, and the other. The biblical texts offer us an opportunity to reflect on the complexities and the wonder of engagement with others as we are moved and empowered by the Spirit, to announce the good news, to bear the burden of historic wrongs, to come alongside and to listen, and much more.

Emergency food and utility assistance, housing rehabilitation projects, thrift stores, and newborn layettes are a few examples of what these ministries do.

All these ministries are supported by our apportionment dollars. We are encouraged to help be the hands and feet of Christ to our neighbors across our wonderful State.

OUTREACH MINISTRIES

In 2022, served over 6,500 in Kanawha and Putnam Counties.

What We Do: We are a community-based organization located in South Charleston, WV supporting our neighbors with their emergency basic needs.

Our Mission: To demonstrate the love of Christ and to minister to needs both physical and spiritual as we assist those who live among us.

Thrift Store

The Heart + Hand Thrift Store is stocked throughout the day with new items received as donations. Those that qualify for assistance receive needed items at no cost through our voucher program. Everyone else is invited...encouraged to come and enjoy shopping. This is a year-round fundraiser for us. Profits from the Thrift Store are used to fund additional assistance programs.

Food Pantry

Heart + Hand is the primary provider of a food pantry for South Charleston and the surrounding area. We receive USDA Commodities and donations from the community. We provide weekend snack bags to South Charleston Middle School students that might not have enough to eat at their home over the weekend and USDA Senior food boxes.

Social Services

Heart + Hand provides basic needs assistance and services for low-income residents of our service areas. Applicants meet with a caseworker at our South Charleston office to identify solutions to their basic needs. Services offered include utility assistance/ Dollar Energy, diapers/hygiene, cleaning supplies/household vouchers, beds for foster children, free medical supplies, furniture vouchers, Christmas program, and community classes.
