The Reverend Dr. Debra Wallace-Padgett will be the Bishop of a joint jurisdiction between the Northeastern and Southeastern Jurisdictions. She will be in service to both the West Virginia Conference and the Holston Conference.

She was elected Bishop of the United Methodist Church in 2012 and at that time, she was lead pastor of St. Luke United Methodist in Lexington, KY – an appointment she served for eight years. Prior to this current assignment, Bishop Wallace-Padgett served both the North Alabama Conference and Holston Conference.

She is a graduate of Berea College, Scarritt College and Graduate School, Lexington Theological Seminary and Asbury Theological Seminary.

Bishop Wallace-Padgett is married to Rev. Lee Padgett, a retired deacon in the United Methodist Church. They are the parents of two adult children, Leanndra Thompson (Alexander) and Andrew Padgett and two granddaughters (Crindalyn Thompson and Raylena Mildred Thompson).
